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## MEMORANDUM TO DAYTICKET ANGLERS

**12th April 2021**

Dear Angler

Following the Government and Angling Trust announcements we can now confirm that we are able to fully open the fishery from April 12<sup>th</sup>.

In order to comply with government legislation, we will be operating pre-booked tickets. We will only be accepting a max of 2 bookings / arrivals per car. We ask that you continue to protect yourselves and we strongly advise that you travel alone in your vehicle unless someone who is from the same household /bubble is fishing with you and when you are fishing please take responsibility and ensure you keep to the social distancing guidelines of at least 2 metres at all times even if you know the other angler.

Even though the current restrictions have been lifted, Wyreside Lake are still abiding by the following policies to protect its customers and staff.

- A max of 2 persons per car, these must be either from the same household or in the same bubble. If any more than 2 arrive in a car – you will be turned away. Anglers must take responsibility for themselves to observe their own local travel restrictions.
- On arrival use the intercom and ask to come through – it will be strictly one car at a time. You will be asked, observing the social distancing ruling, to dip your net, sling, cradle and unhooking mats for a min of 5 minutes. You must wait with your equipment and collect it before waiting outside reception.
- There will be a max 1 person allowed at reception door at any one time. Please use the hand sanitiser outside the doorway, and ensure you are wearing a mask. you will be met at the doorway to sign in verbally with the receptionist.
- You must click the NHS track and trace app / and or give your details to a staff member outside on your arrival.
- There will be no food deliveries and the shop will be closed but we can do a collect service for you on your arrival. It will also be card payment only.
- The 2 men's toilets will remain open.
- We will be open daily from 7am until 5pm – gates close promptly at 5pm. A bailiff will be on duty all day, every day but the reception will only be available between 7-9am daily.
- When your session has ended please come back into reception and sign out with a member of staff and tell them any catch reports. During these initial weeks you will only be able to enter and exit the fishery from 8am until 5pm daily. Please be respectful and do not wait to exit the fishery exactly at 5pm as once our team have locked reception and the top gate there will be no access in or out of the site.

We sincerely apologise for any inconvenience, but we have to ensure we do our part to continue to help fight

Coronavirus and not undo all the hard work and sacrifice that we and the wonderful key workers have all made over the last 9 months . We also have to protect our team who have continued to work during the lockdown period to maintain the grounds and fish stocks. Any angler who does not adhere to these guidelines will lose their booking fee / membership effective immediately without refund.
